We have been observing how our egg changes each day and asking questions in the curiosity corner that we would like to find out about the egg.

We have learnt all of our initial satpin sounds now – it would be great if they were able to be reinforced at home using the flashcards – no long sessions just quick reminders! Every little helps! We are amazed at how quickly they have picked these up and we've now started blending using sounds buttons (as mentioned in the phonics evening). This will be useful for the reading books - please don't feel you have to read a lot of pages- just segmenting words into sounds and modelling blending would be great!
