

Art, D.T. and Music

In Art, the children will learn about the artist, Giuseppe Arcimboldo and they will also complete some creative activities based on the Anglo-Saxons. The children will be practising songs for the Years 3, 4 & 5 production of **Hansel & Gretel**, which will be at the end of Term 4.

PE (Tuesday & Thursday)

The children will have two P.E sessions a week. The children will have swimming on a Tuesday and dance on a Thursday. Please ensure that your child has their P.E. kit in school all week.

Science

In Term 3, we will be studying magnets and forces. The children will look at different types of magnets and magnetic and non-magnetic materials. They will also look at springs to identify the different forces that act in particular directions. In Term 4, pupils will be looking at how to live a healthy lifestyle. The children will investigate the food groups and which groups make up a balanced diet. They will also study the different types of teeth and their function.

English

The children will continue to develop the fluency of their joined-up handwriting each week and will focus on a new spelling pattern or prefix / suffix every Friday. During the Spring Term, we will be writing our own exciting Roman myth and a shape poem, as well as writing formal and informal letters. The children will also produce an informative leaflet about the Anglo-Saxons as part of our topic work.

French

The children will learn the French words for different colours and also use vocabulary for members of the family.

Computing

The children will learn how to generate and read QR codes using an iPad. We will revise how to stay safe online (E-Safety) and report any concerns. Pupils will also use 2Simple Coding on Purple Mash.

Year 3

Terms 3 & 4

The Anglo-Saxons



Geography and History

We will finish looking at Roman Britain and then focus on the Anglo-Saxons. We will look at the Roman withdrawal from Britain in c. AD 410 and at how the Anglo-Saxons came to settle in this country. The children will also extend their geographical knowledge by learning about and locating the different continents.

P.S.H.E.

This unit will address the issues of friendship, co-operation and bullying. It will enable pupils to reflect on the friends that they have and how they keep their friends.

R.E.

We will be looking at the life of Jesus and why he is an inspirational leader for some people. We will learn the difference between a parable and a miracle and use this topic to learn about who is important in our own lives.

Maths

This term we will continue to focus on the core mathematical skills and look at multiplication and division. Pupils will also develop their knowledge of 2-D shapes, money (finding change) and bar charts. This term we are focusing on the three and four times tables.
