Guided reading of different texts including 'Kensuke's Kingdom' with writing activities e.g. Using an orang-utan to make a paintbrush (Instructions). Reading comprehension.

Play scripts, poetry to learn by heart to perform, proof reading and instructional texts.

Handwriting, daily target spellings as well as weekly spellings that are sent home. Synonyms, homophones, adverbs, grammar and punctuation.

Maths

Revision of the 4 operations: Add, subtract (with more than 4 digits), multiply and divide. Read, write, compare and order large numbers and decimals up to 3 places. To read, write, order and round whole numbers up to 1,000,000 and round numbers with 2 decimal places. Use understanding of place value to multiply and divide whole numbers and decimals by 10, 100 and 1000. Times tables, fractions, factors and multiples. Solve one-step and two-step problems and reasoning mathematically.

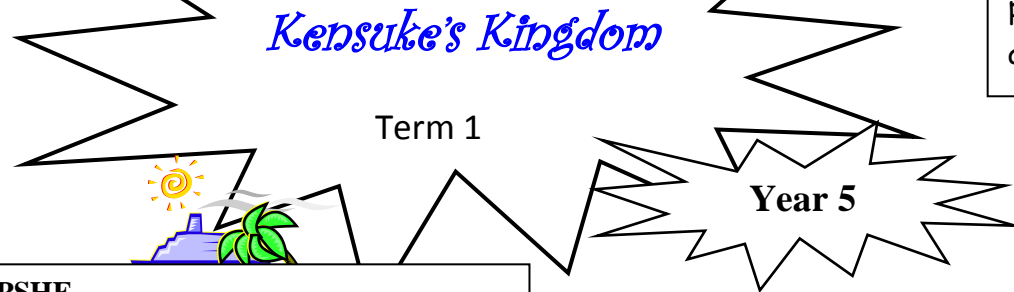
