MATHS:

We will be learning which equipment and standard units we use to measure length, weight and capacity.

We will be revising work on 2 and 3-D shape, and money.

We will be practicing our calculation and problem-solving skills in preparation for our SATs.



ART:

We will be doing observational drawings of plants, and animals then using these as the stimulus for repeating patterns.

We will also complete a collage using materials found in nature.
