Dear Parents,

Re: Year 2 Trip to Hunstanton Tuesday 3rd July 2018

This year we would like to take the Year 2 children to Hunstanton on Tuesday 3rd July for their end of term trip. We will be visiting the Sea-Life Sanctuary and exploring the coastal town. We shall be leaving school at **8.45a.m. and returning at approximately 4.45p.m.**, so a packed lunch will be necessary (no nuts or glass bottles please).

We will need to ask for a voluntary contribution of £27.65 per child to cover the cost of the coach and entry into the Sea-Life Sanctuary. If insufficient contributions are made then the trip will have to be cancelled. We appreciate that this is quite expensive; this is because we are a small class. It is for this reason we haven't had any other trips requiring coach travel this year.

The children can bring £1.50 pocket money with them on the day for an ice cream etc. They need to wear sensible clothing and shoes for a day at the coast and bring a change of clothes (just in case they are needed!) In addition they will need some suntan lotion, a hat and a waterproof coat to cover all eventualities!
